

## ***Law Relative to Information/Computer Crimes***

**Article 1º.** - The one that maliciously destroys or makes unusable a system of information processing or

its parts or components, or prevents or modifies its operation, will be undergo the punishment of prison

from average to maximum degree. If, as a result of this action, the data contained in the system will be

affected, the punishment indicated in the previous interjection will be applied in its maximum degree.

**Article 2º.** - The one that attempts illegally to seize, to use, or to know the information contained in an

information processing system or to intercept or interfere or have access to it, will be punished with a

minor to medium jail sentence.

**Article 3º.** - The one that maliciously alters, damages or destroys the data contained in a system of

information processing, will be punished with a prison sentence of minor to a medium degree.

**Article 4º.** - The one that maliciously reveals or spreads the data contained in an IS will undergo the

punishment with a prison sentence of minor to medium sentence. If the person who incurs these conducts

is the person in charge of the IS, the punishment will be increased in degree. "

And hereby I have reviewed and approved it; therefore it is here enacted to serve as the Law of the

Republic.
