Pursuant to sections 204 and 232 of the Copyright Act 1994, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Commerce and on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

Order

1 Title

- (1) This order is the Copyright (Application to Other Countries) Amendment Order 2000.
- (2) In this order, the Copyright (Application to Other Countries) Order 1995 is called "the principal order".

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

3 New Schedules 1 to 3 substituted

Substituted Schedules 1 to 3 of principal order, as set out in the Schedule of this order.

4 Revocation

Revoked the Copyright (Application to Other Countries) Amendment Order 1997.
